For more than 20 years, his work has primarily served non-traditional students including at-risk males, minorities, first-generation college attendees, adult learners, veterans, and disabled students.

During his tenure on the commission, Chair Johnson was instrumental in legislative advocacy successes for the commission and the African American Heritage Preservation Program grant. He was also the catalyst for the historic name change of the soon-to-be Banneker-Douglass-Tubman Museum!
